Pastor's Report to Council—April 2025

As always, please feel free to let me know if you need additional or different material shared in the Pastor's Report.

Worship and Music

- Worship Leadership from March 30—While our family was on vacation for our kids' and Sarah's spring break, we had our own member, Rev. Holli Burkard, preside in worship and Vicar Natalie lead the rest of the liturgy and preach. Things seem to have gone smoothly from what I could see online, but I wanted to see if there are any notes for how to help things go smoothly in future weeks I am away in time to come.
- Guest Presenter from Isaiah 117 House in March—We did have Jennifer Bohnsack present during worship on March 16, and again, it seemed that things went acceptably (other than her speaking for longer than we had requested of her). While I do not foresee having frequent guest presenters like this, it seems like we have found a good format for including special presenters on occasion while also including the other essentials for worship on these Sundays (still keeping readings, and children's sermon modified to include adults, and still having Holy Communion). Again, I would invite any feedback here.
- Holy Week Plans—We will have usual times for worship on Palm Sunday and Easter Sunday, and we'll have Maundy Thursday at 7:00pm, Good Friday at 7:00pm, and the join with Zion, Waterville for their turn hosting the Holy Saturday Easter Vigil at 7:00pm on April 19.
- Baptism on Easter Sunday—We will have the baptism of Marek Boytim on Easter Sunday at the 10:00am service. This is actually one of the ideal times, liturgically speaking, for celebrating a baptism, since the connections to Jesus' own death and resurrection are so clear and since the practice of the ancient church was often to have people prepare for baptism in the season leading up to Easter, to be baptized at the celebration of Christ's Resurrection on Easter Sunday. The Boytims will also join the congregation that day.
- <u>Possible Additional Baptism this Spring</u>—Alyssa Stout, granddaughter of our Cherryl Stout, met with me earlier in Lent to discuss baptism of her new baby. Her two older children were baptized here in the time of Pastor Matt, and we are working on the details of timing.

Christian Education and Youth

- Adult Class (Sundays)—Our current series on the Didache finishes on April 6, and then a new series on imagery, symbolism, and art work in Christian faith begins on April 13.
- <u>Sunday School for Children and Youth</u>—We continue to offer Sunday School for kids weekly, with varying numbers in our classes each week, but with the plan to continue with our model of weekly rotating teachers for the rest of this school year. The Children's Sunday School classes will be having their Easter Egg Hunt during the Sunday School hour on Easter Sunday.
- Collaboration with UMC/ELCA Neighboring Congregations for Anthony Wayne Youth Group—We have a plan for and end of school year/beginning of summer event to go to a Mudhens game at the end of June, and are also working on a service project date for the spring. Our next planning meeting will be this week on Thursday, April 10.

- Confirmation Program—Our confirmation students will be a part of the Easter Vigil on April 19; we are also preparing for special events for our second-year students who will be confirmed this late spring: handprints on a large painted canvas, which will eventually have their confirmation verses added to them; t-shirts from Old Lutheran for those who are being confirmed, and the return of our traditional celebration meal for those being confirmed. I am proposing this year that our students be confirmed on June 1 (the 7th Sunday of Easter this year), rather than the usual Pentecost Sunday, because one of our families has shared with me that they will be out of state on the following weekend, June 8, and we would like all to have the chance to be confirmed on the same date.
- <u>Thursday Afternoon Bible Study</u>—Our most recent series, called "When God Breaks the Rules," concluded in March, and a new series on the book of Judges begins after Easter.
- <u>Vicar Natalie's Summer Spirituality Series</u>: Vicar Natalie's plan for a summer-long series of Thursday evening events is coming together nicely, with a number of guest presenters from beyond our congregation (including Bishop Beaudoin, Pastor Chris Hanley from Glenwood Lutheran by the art museum, Pastor Sarah Schaaf from Synod Staff, Pastor Warren Clifton from Hope UMC, and others.
- Joint Children Youth Family Ministry Coordinator with Providence—Over the past month, I've been a part of 4-6 first-round interviews with potential candidates and got as far as second interviews with a couple of them; we have plans for second-round interviews with two possible candidates in the next two weeks. So we are making progress with finding local potential candidates for this position, even though I know it has been difficult for all of us to be patient through the process.

Membership

• New Members to Be Received—As mentioned, the Boytim family (Heather, Dough, Evangeline, and Marek) will join the congregation on Easter Sunday. I have also met with the Crippen family (Marsha and Louis) who have expressed interest in transferring their membership from Providence, and who actually live in Whitehouse and basically pass Community of Christ to get to Providence currently. They have been worshiping with us since late February/early March and are ready to join. They'll let me know about possible good dates on their calendar coming up later this spring.

Concert Committee

- <u>Chamber Ensemble Concert</u>—The Perrysburg Symphony Orchestra Chamber Ensemble gave a great concert on March 23, and things went smoothly with that event, with proceeds again to be divided between our building fund and Lutheran Disaster Response.
- Swingmania, Charity Auction, and Burger Bar Night—This evening will have several parts to it. We'll have a dinner open to church members at 5:00pm featuring burgers, chips, cole slaw, and ice cream, followed by a charitable auction event at 6:00pm with a wide assortment of prizes whose proceeds will benefit Genacross Lutheran Services, and then a 7:00pm concert with room for dancing, all to the musical stylings of Swingmania. Meal tickets will be \$10.00 for an adult, \$5.00 for kids 10 and under, and then concert tickets will be \$25.00 for an individual, \$40.00 for a couple, and \$10.00 for kids (again, 10 and under). The whole

evening's events will also help to benefit both our Community of Christ Building Fund as well as Lutheran Disaster Relief, as with other concerts hosted by the Concert Committee.

<u>Leadership</u>

<u>Goal:</u>I will serve the congregation in their mission as the church to make Jesus known. I will attend council meetings and other core ministry group meetings as a listening ear and a contributor to ideas. I will be a servant leader who will serve alongside the congregation and community to address the needs of the neighbor. I will also help lead in collaboration with other area congregations and be engaged with ways to collaborate on various events and worship experiences.

- Attended Council Meetings once a month.
- Attend various core ministry group meetings when available (details listed under each category); have provided ideas and affirmation in group settings with those in attendance.

Theological Articulation

<u>Goal:</u> I will regularly receive feedback from my supervising pastor, internship worship committees regarding my theological statements to make sure they are articulated and understood clearly. I will also be open to feedback from my supervisor in the way I preach, teach, and converse about the Christian faith. My goal is to study and learn further during this internship also, whether it is through reading or attending events. I also will engage weekly with a text study group with a group of pastors in the area to hear various perspectives on scripture.

- Text study group on Tuesdays have been attending when available
- "Crazy Faith Talk" Podcast (November-present)- engaging weekly on the podcast to discuss various biblical and theological topics with Pr. Steve (supervisor), Pr. Sarah Aasheim, Pr. Erica Wellner

Leading Worship

<u>Goal:</u> I will participate in various worship capacities involving lector, assisting minister, and singing/speaking liturgy. This will involve both Sunday morning worship, Wednesday evening worship, and other special services as needed. My goal is to continue to improve in my communication skills and presentation in front of both large and small group worship.

- Worship and Music Meetings Attended (Oct. 3rd, Nov. 7th, Dec. 5th, Jan. 2nd, Mar. 6th)
- Leading Liturgy in worship began a more active role in leading liturgy in worship starting in March.
- Solo worship service March 30th (Pr. Holli Burkard presided at the table)
- Solo worship service April 2nd for Midweek Lent
- Involved in planning of Christmas and Holy Week worship services

Preaching

<u>Goal</u>: I will continue to work and build upon the development of my theological structure in preaching. This includes working on the foundation of a concise thesis statement to frame the whole sermon. I would like to receive feedback on specific details within my sermon to help how to craft my sermon and find my preaching voice. I also would like to further my faith imagination, especially when relating the text to today's reality to connect further with the hearers of this sermon at this time and place. I would like to try different preaching styles, such as preaching out front without notes. My plan is to preach once a month for the first six months, every three weeks months 7-12, and every other week months 13-18. I also will plan a time when I will preach three weeks in a row.

- September 29th (St. Michael and All Angels)
- October 20th (22nd Sunday after Pentecost)
- November 24th (Christ the King Sunday)
- November 24th Thanksgiving Worship (at Hope United Methodist Church)
- December 11th (midweek Advent)
- January 19th
- February 16th
- March 30th (4th Sunday in Lent)
- April 2nd Midweek Lent (included a spiritual practice on Psalm 32)
- Worked on sermon development by reading Four Pages of the Sermon. Also have received feedback from Pastor Steve and others from the intern committee and worship and music.

Teaching Adults

<u>Goal:</u> I will collaborate with my supervising pastor and the Education committee on opportunities to teach and lead, whether it be in small group bible study or Sunday morning faith formation. My goal is to develop curriculum that engages with the interest, needs, concerns of the faith community.

Bible Studies:

- "Things Seen and Unseen Bible Study on Angels" (December-January) coordinated, planned, and co-taught this series with Pastor Steve.
- "When God Breaks the Rules Bible Study" (January-March)- co-taught in this series with Pastor Steve.
- "The Good, the Bad, the Ugly Bible Study on the Book of Judges"- I compiled this bible study outline to be taught after Holy Week. Pastor Steve and I will split up the teaching each week.

Adult Sunday School:

 November 17th- "On the Other Hand..." - study on the bible offering different perspectives. I co-led with Pastor Steve on discussing scripture dealing with faith and works.

- January 5th- "The Names of Jesus" a study written by me walking the class through the various names of Jesus and where they show up in the Biblical text and history.
- February-April "Walking with Jesus: Lessons from the Didache" co-taught with Pastor Steve alternating weeks walking through text from the Didache. Drawing from scripture, church history, and present day examples on discipleship.

Teaching Youth and Children

<u>Goal:</u> I will work on teaching with children as needed in collaboration with the education committee. I will try to engage and sit in on Sunday school every month to engage with the students. I also will help with teaching at Vacation Bible School as needed. I will ask my worship committee and supervisor pastor to provide feedback on my children sermons and engagement in teaching with children.

- Children sermons on days preached
- Confirmation Class help lead and teach twice a month in confirmation. Have been part of the planning meetings with Pastor Steve, Pastor Meg and Minister John. Taught education portions on February 23rd (Baptism) and March 20th (Communion).
- Confirmation Field Trips: October 19th @ St. Michael's Byzantine Catholic Church in Rossford; January 10th @ Temple Shomar Emunim
- Have observed Sunday school once in each classroom so far.

Evangelism

<u>Goal:</u> I will explore the outreach and social action committees how to engage in the church and community. I will explore with the congregation on how to engage and welcome visitors to the church. I also will put into practice the sharing of my own faith story and how it has shaped my call and my Christian journey. I also would like to further invite others through a class or workshop to learn about sharing faith stories with others, either through a class or workshop.

- Faith stories shared in Confirmation class when discussing Baptism and Communion and also in adult education and preaching.
- Summer Spirituality Series putting together a series that will happened every Thursday
 evening from June through August that will invite people to try a different spiritual
 practice each week. We will have various leaders from the community to lead and teach.
 The goal is not only to invite people to try new practices, but also to explore their own
 faith story through these practices.

Pastoral Care

Goal: I will accompany my supervisor pastor on pastoral care visits to have a chance to get to know those who are on the pastoral care list. I will also attend when available the visitation group meetings to learn who is on our visitation and homebound list. I will also coordinate eventually with my supervisor pastor on doing pastoral care visits on my own and figure out an appropriate rotation and schedule per the needs of the congregation.

- I have been helping with pastoral visits when invited by Pastor Steve. While Pastor Steve was gone, I also was on call as the pastoral care presence. I will plan to do further pastoral care visits in the summer.
- Attended Visitation meetings on October 7th, November 4th, January 6th, March 3rd, April 7th
- Attended the Conversations and More on February 21st.
- May 3rd- plan to lead an End of Life information meeting with Pastor Steve.

Administration

<u>Goal:</u> I will participate in staff meetings, council meetings, and other necessary administrative meetings to learn process of the administration side of the church. I will also dedicate time in some supervisor sessions to talk further regarding healthy leadership and interpersonal dynamics. I will read texts pertaining to this topic to further develop understanding and skills in this area.

- Council Retreat Presentation "Group Dynamics and Healthy Leading" in this session, I
 presented ideas on how to create safe group dynamics that encourage active listening,
 mutual purpose and vision, healthy conflict in important conversations, and
 self-awareness when interacting together and in the congregation.
- Child Safety Policy (March) Beginning stages of discussing updating the child safety policy and exploring reopening the nursery in the church. This is still in the beginning stages.

Stewardship Leadership

<u>Goal:</u> This fall, I was part of the Faith Formation Stewardship class at Community of Christ. I will walk with others through these stewardship practices not only as a voice of encouragement, but also as one who practices these acts of stewardship myself in the community. I will share my own talents through various means within the church and giving my time to the areas that I am especially called to in the church. I will lead through my encouragement, preaching, and teaching to help others explore areas of stewardship.

Leadership of Social Ministry
